Épernay France	<b>Moët &amp; Chandon Brut Impérial Rosé</b> This Champagne displays lively, expressive, aromas dominated by the scent of wild strawberries. It is full-bodied, with zestful, assertive fruitiness.	1 900

# CAP CLASSIQUE

Franschhoek	<b>L'Ormarins Brut NV</b> Good vibrance and crisp crunch of acidity to balance the ripe fruitiness. Rounded, creamy, broad and textured in the mouth. Elegant and statuesque. Its long aftertaste finishes on a light lemon zest note.	290
Franschhoek	<b>Pierre Jordan Belle Rose NV</b> The palate reveals a lively presentation of rich strawberry and cherry flavours derived from Pinot Noir with an elegant dry finish.	290 Glass 60
Stellenbosch	<b>Simonsig Kaapse Vonkel Brut Rosé</b> A celebration of refreshing flavours tantalise the palate while the subtle yet crisp acidity causes an array of lingering high notes. This vibrant sparkling rosé reflects elegance, style and finesse.	300

# SAUVIGNON BLANC

Elgin	<b>Paul Cluver</b> The nose is clean and fresh with expressive granadilla, grape fruit, gooseberry and blackcurrant characteristics.	220
Durbanville	<b>De Grendel</b> The fruit follows through on the palate, giving it richness and resulting in full well balanced mouth feel that ends with a crisp dry acidity.	230
Constantia	<b>Klein Constantia Estate</b> A delicate combination of elegant tropical fruit with a savoury minerality showcasing the Klein Constantia terroir, a common thread in our Sauvignon blancs.	310
Elim	<b>Ghost Corner</b> A unique Sauvignon blanc that cannot be compared to any other. Powerful concentrated layers of green figs and gooseberries, with a touch of grapefruit, fynbos and a steely minerality on the palate.	430
Stellenbosch	<b>Ken Forrester Reserve</b> This wine shows lovely complexity with mix of tangy grassy notes, fig leaf, and peach and nectarine nuances. Brisk acidity with minerality on the palate which is typical of the long hang time in our cool region	180
Cederberg	<b>Cederberg</b> An aromatic Sauvignon Blanc with grassy notes, white asparagus undertones and strong hints of capsicum, gooseberries and lemon zest. A refreshing, crisp acidity finishes off the initial sensation of creaminess on the mid-palate	250

# CHARDONNAY

## Unwooded

Roberston	<b>De Wetshof Limestone Hill</b> An un-wooded wine, Limestone Hill has notes of grapefruit and nuts, with the complexity balanced by a nuanced elegance ending with a delicate ripeness.	190
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## Wooded

Stellenbosch	<b>The Stellenbosch Reserve</b> This wine is a great, complex wine with a good balance between fresh acidity and creamy roundness, and an amazingly elegant finish.	290
Stellenbosch	<b>Tokara</b> The mid-palate has stunning vibrant flavours of lemon preserve and lime zest. There is creaminess to the mid-palate leading to notes of toasted almonds and vanilla on the dry long finish.	210
Stellenbosch	<b>Delaire Graff Banghoek Reserve</b> Elegant with layered nuances of vanilla, peaches and honeycomb. A hint of minerality adds to lingering finish.	390
Hemel en Aarde	<b>Hamilton Russell</b> A tight, minerally wine with classic Hamilton Russell Vineyards length and complexity. Unusually prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality.	830

# CHENIN BLANC

Stellenbosch	<b>Mulderbosch Steen op Hout</b> It shows sensational freshness, and creates a long lasting finish that literally meanders for minutes after each delicious sip.	170
Stellenbosch	<b>Klein Zalze Family Reserve</b> Concentrated aromas of lime, winter melon and herbs on the nose with layers of citrus and elderflower on the palate. Elegant fruit and integrated French oak flavours give this wine a creamy mouth feel and a long, fresh, earthy finish.	390
Stellenbosch	<b>Ken Forrester FMC</b> The pinnacle of what we consider to be the finest expression of the grapes of this varietal - an icon Chenin, a challenge to the world! Rich, layered with dried apricot, vanilla and honey.	1 000
Cederberg	<b>Cederberg</b> Five months less contact ensured amouth coating creaminess on the palate with a lively crisp acidity to finish off. Altitude vineyards make this Chenin Blanc truly unique.	200

# WHITE BLENDS

Stellenbosch	<b>Tokara Director's Reserve</b> The palate is complex, and full of flavours. The oaking is perfectly balanced with intense fruit flavours and notes of buttered toast. The mid palate is rich and mouth filling with a stunning grip and a long crisp finish.	590
Elim	<b>Ghost Corner Bowline</b> The Bowline. Green fig and dusty elements from the Semillon complement the ripe asparagus notes from the Sauvignon Blanc. A complex wine with well balanced oak with a refreshing, smooth finish.	420
Tulbagh	<b>Saronsberg Provenance Earth in Motion</b> The Earth in Motion has prominent tropical aromas with the Sauvignon Blanc contributing delicate gooseberry, exotic fruit and a hint of minerality; the Chenin Blanc provides white pear, litchi and floral notes.	140
Stellenbosch	<b>Marvelous</b> A vibrant, mineral core firmly supports the wine, framing the multi-layered palate. Papaya, custard apple, blood orange and more, form an exotic mélange.	220

# ROSÉ

Stellenbosch	<b>Mulderbosch Cabernet Sauvignon</b> Fresh acidity and a low alcohol provide the savoury core of this wine, yet the abundance of Cabernet Sauvignon fruit flavours such as fresh strawberries, ripe cherries and subtle notes of white peach provide the immediate joy of a basket of inviting summer fruits.	150
Durbanville	<b>De Grendel Shiraz</b> The wine has a crisp, dry finish with a very well-structured natural acidity.	140
Stellenbosch	<b>Delaire Graff Cabernet Franc</b> Made from 100% free run juice, this unique Rosé displays flavours of ripe strawberries, cassis and candyfloss with dark red berries and cream on the mid palate and a juicy, crisp and dry finish.	200



# CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Stellenbosch	<b>Le Riche Reserve</b> The palate shows classy Cabernet flavours and soft, supple tannins with a firm structure. The rich, juicy entry is followed by an elegant mid-palate and long, lingering finish.	1000
Stellenbosch	<b>Rust en Vrede Estate Vineyard</b> A firm tannin structure is in balance with red fruit and liquorice flavours supported by a subtle oak component which fills the mid palate and carries through to the finish.	620
Stellenbosch	<b>Tokara</b> The palate has stunning flavours of dark cherries, cassis and a certain savoury saltiness to it. The wine has a lingering finish with clean silky tannins and a touch of oak sweetness.	260
Stellenbosch	<b>The Stellenbosch Reserve</b> The deep fruit and savory notes show fantastic follow through onto the palate, with a wonderful dark chocolate/mocha undertone that adds to the complexity that is associated with a true Stellenbosch Cabernet Sauvignon.	340
Stellenbosch	<b>Waterford</b> The wine is elegantly structured with a typical tight and dry structure which finishes with great balance.	550
Stellenbosch	<b>Rustenberg Peter Barlow</b> This wine is made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from our very finest vineyard. It is characterized by an upfront perfume, intermingled with concentrated cassis, black cherries and some herbaceousness.	790

# MERLOT

Stellenbosch	<b>Meinert</b> Fresh, rich brick red colour. Dried herbs and ripe berries, quite a heady nose, no doubt it will settle some more.	300
Stellenbosch	<b>Ken Forrester Pat's Garden</b> Hints of cherries and mint with meat-spice and smoky undertones.	290
Elgin	<b>Shannon Mount Bullet</b> The wine has a fragrance of ripe red fruits such as plums and dark cherries, with earthy complexity and yet still expressing minerality. Maintaining a good acidity lends to outstanding freshness with a well-integrated ripe and seductive tannin structure.	780
Stellenbosch	<b>Hartenberg</b> The palate is medium/full bodied, realing juicy fruit, wonderful texture, fine grained tannins and a silky finish	415
Stellenbosch	<b>Meerlust</b> The full bodied palate offers generous, ripe, pure Merlot fruit with refreshing acidity, structured yet silky tannins and pronounced length and minerality.	640

# SHIRAZ

Tulbagh	<b>Saronsberg Provenance</b> The soft textured tannins, full-bodied mouth-feel and silken finish lends itself as a platform for a heady mix of red berry and black fruit flavours combined with floral notes and fynbos nuances.	240
Stellenbosch	<b>Hartenberg</b> Deep black - red in colour and spicy, earthy notes on bouquet entry. The palate is rich, fruit-driven and has great balance. Fine, powdery tannins finish the wine.	400
Durbanville	<b>De Grendel</b> Violets and pepper weave through wild black berries and spice with subtle oak support from élevage in a combination of French and American oak, partially new.	330
Stellenbosch	<b>Tokara Reserve Collection</b> The palate is heady and dark with stunning dry textured tannins and a lingering finish. The wine is beautifully balanced with a certain amount of restraint.	700
Stellenbosch	<b>Delaire Graff</b> This juicy, ripe and approachable Shiraz with its ruby colour and purple tints has a spicy white pepper undertone as well as lavender and dark red fruit aromas of mulberries.	220

# PINOTAGE

Stellenbosch	<b>Meinert Printer's Ink</b> Medium structure with a rich, full-bodied yet elegant mid-palate and a clean fresh finish. We place the emphasis on fruit flavours by using gentle extraction methods, thereby also avoiding hard tannins.	600
Stellenbosch	<b>Simonsig Redhil</b> The lavish flavours of ripe plums and maraschino cherries embroider the palate. Spicy layers of cedar oak polish the tannins, giving the wine an elegant longevity.	760
Tulbagh	<b>Rijks Private Cellar</b> This world-class wine has a deep ruby red colour. An orchestra of red berries, cherry and plum aromas are present, while backed by pure Pinotage fruit.	520
Stellenbosch	<b>Kanonkop</b> A complex wine with hints of red fruit and mocha flavours. Elegant tannin structures with a good length and dry finish.	820
Constantia	<b>Groot Constantia</b> A rich cool climate Pinotage with deep, dark red colour. A multi-layered complexity of bright redfruit, black berries, black cherries, plums and ripe strawberries with hints of dark chocolate and cinnamon spice on the nose.	460

# PINOT NOIR

Elgin	<b>Paul Cluver Seven Flags</b> Andries believes that the essence of a great Pinot noir is the purity of fruit and the structure of the wine. This wine has this essence, substantiated by its natural acidity.	1150
Elim	<b>Ghost Corner</b> A beautifully crafted Pinot noir with prominent red fruit of ripe cherries and sweet raspberries with an undertone of earthy, mushroom nuances.	450
Elgin	<b>Yardstick</b> The lifted floral notes of potpourri and ripe raspberries are offset by hints of 'tabac brune' and a pleasant earthy character. The palate has fine grained tannins with wonderful earthy flavours complemented by spice and black olive tapenade.	340
Franschhoek	<b>Haute Cabrière Unwooded</b> The beautiful ruby red colour is indicative of the red berry aromas, which follow through to the palate showing enticing, concentrated ripe cherry.	230

# RED BLENDS

Franschhoek	<b>La Motte Millennium</b> The nose of this wine tells the story of how it was made. Raspberry (Merlot), a slight herbaciousness (Cabernet Franc) and English toffee (oak) combine in a harmonious way. Malbec and Petit Verdot provide colour and spice.	220
Stellenbosch	<b>Ken Forrester Renegade</b> This elegant Rhône blend displays Old World Style with New World fruit. Hint of Grenache's earthy rusticity and Shiraz's noble spice with hints of nutmeg and salty black olive on the finish.	290
Franschhoek	<b>Rupert &amp; Rothschilds Classique</b> Inviting cranberry and raspberry aromas with an earthy, mineral focus and a lingering cinnamon and walnut finish.	350
Stellenbosch	<b>Rustenberg John X Merriman</b> Plum and cigar-box aromatics prelude a multi-layered palate with an elegant tannin structure. This Bordeaux blend typifies Rustenberg terroir and has good ageing potential, if cellared correctly.	390
Stellenbosch	<b>Vergelegen Premium Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot</b> A pliant, mid-weight wine with noteworthy richness and a firm spine of harmonious acidity to its intense berry and spice flavours.	630
Stellenbosch	<b>Meinert Synchronicity</b> A classic wine, it has power and complexity alongside balance, and red fruit aromas and cigar box whiffs. It is unashamedly aimed at collectors and those seeking wines with character.	700

# WINE BY THE GLASS

Durbanville: Diemersdal

“At Diemersdal we blend the old and new worlds of winemaking. In pursuit of the award-winning red wines that give expression to the rich diversity of the terroir, we use traditional open fermenters to enhance the natural flavours and soften the tannins in our grapes. We take great care in choosing the barrels for each cultivar. For the white wines, we have a brand new state-of-the art winery where we adopt an approach of minimum intervention to conserve prominent varietal character. To continually produce unique wines, our winemakers pay meticulous attention to detail and spend time experimenting with new techniques, barrels and yeasts.”

Sauvignon Blanc 60

The distinctive aromas support a wonderfully balanced palate, presenting purity of ripe fruit, coupled with a lingering harmonious finish.

Unwooded Chardonnay 60

This fashionable wine balances concentrated spicy aromas with fresh fruit flavours. Nuance of limes on the palate combine to offer you a delicious, flavourful wine with a creamy taste and lingering aftertaste.

Sauvignon Rosé 60

Delicate, fruity and lively, with distinctive Sauvignon Blanc aromas of passion fruit and lime, with hints of the cherry and strawberry flavours of Cabernet Sauvignon. A balanced palate with crisp acidity and fruity undertones.

Merlot 80

The nose seduces with beautiful ripe blackberry and dried fruit aromas along with spicy undertones. This wine is well structured with elegance and mouth filling fruit flavours. Hints of cedarwood, mint and spice flavours follow through on the palate.

Pinotage 80

This wine shows a complex nose of red fruits, vanilla, exotic spices, and rich dark chocolate aromas. The palate is full flavoured and smoothly textured with oriental spice, chocolate and roasted banana flavours.
